ORDER

Service and Payroll Administrative Repository for Kerala (SPARK) is a MGP initiative for the development and implementation of an integrated personnel and payroll information system for the Government employees in Kerala. It deals with the Establishment of Government employees including Service Matters, Salary Matters, Income Tax Matters, Accounts Matters, Personnel and Payroll through a web based software. On the basis of the decision taken in the meeting of the MGP Steering cum Empowered Committee (MGPSEC) held on 26.10.2005, orders have been issued entrusting the ownership and co-ownership of the project SPARK to IT Department and Finance Department respectively, vide Government order read above. In the Government Order it has been specifically mentioned that a Co-ordination Committee with representatives from Finance, MGP and NIC, to chart out an implementation schedule for the project, and a Technical Committee comprising of Networking and Hardware experts for proposing a detailed plan for enabling efficient remote connectivity to the SPARK project utilizing State Information Infrastructure, will be constituted.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to constitute a Co-ordination Committee with the following members to chart out an implementation schedule for the project:-

1. Representative from Finance Department.
2. Representative from G.A (MGP) Department.

3. Deputy Secretary , IT Department (Convener).
4. Representative from National Informatics Centre.

Government are also pleased to constitute a Technical Committee with the following members for proposing a detailed plan for enabling efficient remote connectivity to the SPARK project utilizing State Information Infrastructure:-
