

Tutorial Regarding “ Email ID updation in SPARK”

A new feature has been introduced in the SPARK software that allows employees with login access to update their email addresses.

⚠ Employees having login in SPARK (Individual/Establishment login privilege/DDOs) can use this module to update their Email ID in SPARK profile.

⚠ Once the email address has been successfully updated, the existing Email ID will be replaced with the new one; however, if an employee's Email ID has not yet been updated in SPARK, they can follow the same workflow to make the change."

STEPS FOR UPDATING EMAIL ID IN SPARK

Step 1) Employee login : Employee need to enter the login credential Ref fig:1

Step 2) A page will appear i.e **Update Email ID or Aadhaar Linked Mobile Number in SPARK**, In which the message **“You have not yet verified eMail ID in SPARK. Do you want to continue to verify and update it now ?”** will be seen . Ref fig: 2

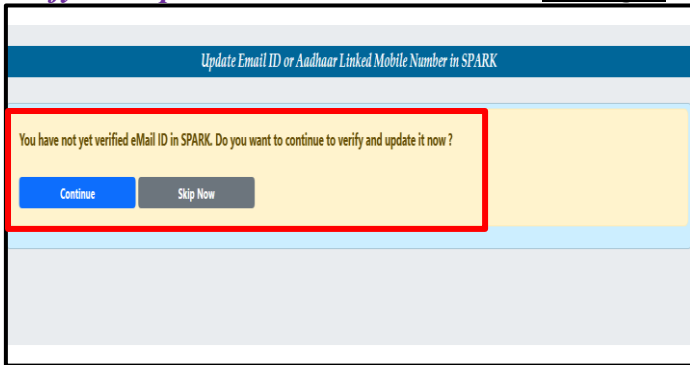

Step 3) To proceed with updating the Email ID, the employee must click the **CONTINUE** button. This will bring up a field for entering the new Email ID, after which the employee should input their preferred Email ID and click the **Send OTP** button to receive the OTP at the specified address. Ref fig: 3

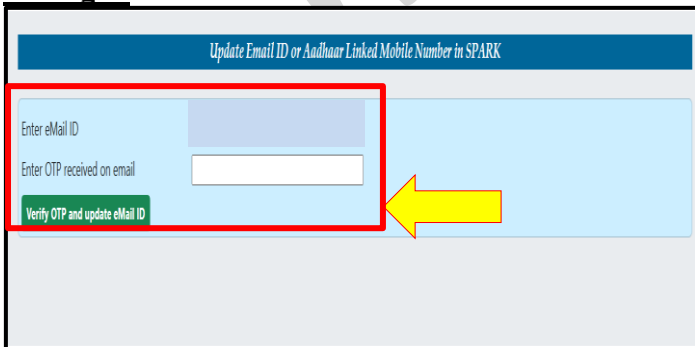

Step 4) The employee will then receive the OTP in their new email ID, enter it in the designated field (in SPARK), and click **“Verify OTP and update Email ID”**, which will trigger a confirmation pop-up message indicating that their email ID has been successfully updated. Click on the **Login** button to login again. Ref fig: 4

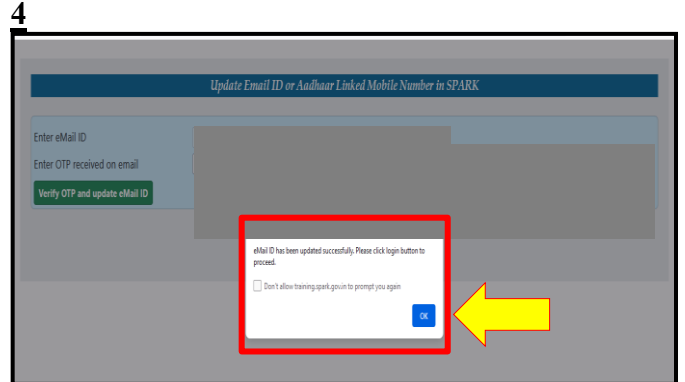

Step 5) If the mobile number linked to Aadhaar is not updated in SPARK, employees can simultaneously update both their Email ID and the Aadhaar-linked mobile number through the mentioned process itself Ref fig: 5

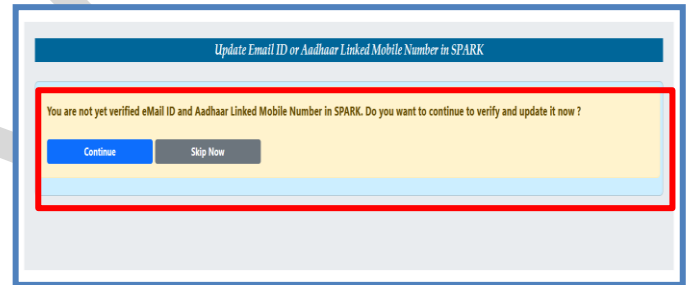

Step 6) Employee need to update the Email ID initially then Mobile number([Tutorials for the same has already been updated](#) [Click here](#)) Ref fig:6

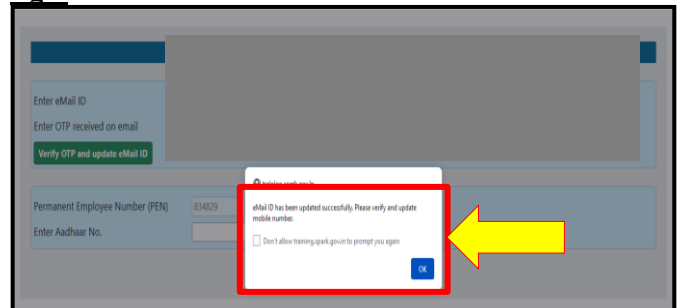
